



Memorandum of Understanding

Goals: The primary goal of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to build a cooperative partnership between GACD and the Conservation District by engaging the District in a locally based demonstration project of Feral Swine Control Policies and Practices. The effective execution of this local project by the District will provide farmers and landowners in the District a process and information to support feral swine control efforts. By managing a well-documented process on a local basis, the District will be assisting in a larger collaborative effort by GACD to help develop documentation for a process that can be effective on a state-wide basis, while at the same time providing a local support program to the community.

It is understood that GACD will provide funding in the amount of up to \$ for purchasing certain defined equipment and providing the documentation and reporting of this project to GACD.

In return for this funding, the District, hereby agrees to:

- Enter into an agreement with a local “Hog Control Custodian”
- Provide all other services required to constitute an operable feral hog control program
- Maintain feral hog control equipment / property accountability through a property record
- Hand Receipt feral hog control equipment to Hog Control Custodian
- Ensure that all equipment is maintained in good operating condition
- Provide a monthly activity report to GACD detailing:
 - Report numbers and sex of all hogs trapped and killed in each classification (mature, juvenile, pigs) as well as specific site location (preferable gps coordinates)
 - Report numbers and sex of all hogs killed at night using thermal sighting in each classification (mature, juvenile, pigs) as well as specific site location (preferable gps coordinates)
 - Other information that may be requested

The period for this agreement shall begin on the date of the last signature and will continue

until terminated in writing by either party. Should the agreement be terminated by either party, all equipment purchased under this agreement shall then become the property of GACD and returned to GACD or transferred to another SWCD selected by GACD in good operating condition.
