- 3. Grant request maximum- \$1,000
- 4. If you are awarded a grant, you must submit a W-9 form in order to receive the money.
- 5. Grantees must notify Ocmulgee River Soil & Water Conservation District (SWCD) when they have received the funds. <u>Grantees should receive the funds no later than the end of December</u>.
- 6. Grantees must submit a report on the progress/plan including photos (if applicable) to the Ocmulgee River Georgia SWCD (leanne.chafin@gacd.us) by May 31, 2024 or they must notify the SWCD if the money is not used within the time period.
- 7. Eligible grantees are educators from any school, grade levels Pre-K through 12th, or other eligible entities within the following counties: **Bibb**, **Crawford**, **Dooly**, **Houston**, **Macon**, **each**, **Pulaski**, **Taylor** and **Wilcox Counties**.
